Using Financial Aid/Loan For Course

If you are going to use the financial aid option to pay for the course, you will need to choose the terms of your financial aid/loan by selecting those terms on the enrollment form. Fill out all information and click the "Continue Secure Enrollment" button at the bottom of the page. You do NOT need to fill out any of the credit card information on the page.

We will take the information that you submitted and create the appropriate financial aid/loan documents. We will email or regular mail the documents to you depending on what you selected on the enrollment form.

When you receive the financial aid/loan documents you will need to sign and return them to us along with your down payment.

When we receive your financial aid/loan documents and down payment you will receive a welcome email with your course login information. You will now have access to all course materials. Begin working through the chapters at your own pace.

Your text book/s ship within 24 hrs of us receiving your financial aid/loan documents and down payment (except weekends). Text book/s ship directly from the publisher with most students receiving them in 3 to 4 business days.

The course work is best completed in the order that it is delivered. Your knowledge and skills are built upon as you go. That said, you are free to move through the material in any way you want.

You will be provided with an FISDAP online account that you will use to track a minimum of 10 patient contacts. A tutorial is available in your course. Begin working on the patient contact process. We will assist you with scheduling time in a hospital, ambulance agency or fire department near you. If this is not possible we can schedule you at an agency near the EMT & Fire Training Center before or after skills week.

Complete all course work with a final grade of 80% or better.

Show up for your scheduled skills week and get 40-50 hours of hands on professional instruction. Pass your in course assessment exams covering all skills.

Take an NREMT practical skills assessment exam and an NREMT computer based exam and pass both.

You will receive a welcome email with your course login information and other details that allow you immediate access to all course materials. Begin working through the chapters at your own pace.
